

Nomination Procedures for Wall of Gallantry and Wall of Remembrance

The Coast Guard Academy accepts nominations for the Wall of Gallantry and Wall of Remembrance year-round. The cut-off date for consideration is April 15th and those selected will be inducted the following April.

Wall of Gallantry:

Eligible graduates for the Wall of Gallantry are those who have distinguished themselves during operations and have received one of the following awards:

- (a) Medal of Honor
- (b) Navy Cross
- (c) Gold Medal of Congress
- (d) Silver Star
- (e) Legion of Merit (with combat "V")
- (f) Distinguished Flying Cross
- (g) Coast Guard Medal
- (h) Navy and Marine Corps Medal
- (i) Gold Lifesaving Medal
- (j) Bronze Star
- (k) Silver Lifesaving Medal
- (l) NASA Space Flight Medal

Combat Operations are no longer required for eligibility for the Distinguished Flying Cross. Graduates who do not meet the above criteria may still be eligible. At a minimum, all nominations must include name, graduation year and a copy of the qualifying citation. All previously submitted nominations that have not been chosen for induction will be considered each subsequent year. A maximum of 12 graduates will be selected for induction each year.

Wall of Remembrance:

The Wall of Remembrance honors Academy graduates who have perished while carrying out an operational mission. Please include a summation detailing the situation in which the alumnus perished. A comprehensive list of all graduates who are honored on the Wall of Remembrance is included on the [webpage](#). Please forward supporting documentation for any graduate that meets the criteria and is not listed.

The inductees will be informally recognized at the Alumni Awards Banquet during Homecoming and a Spring Hall of Heroes Induction Ceremony and Regimental Review will be conducted to formally honor and enshrine those selected to the Wall of Gallantry and Wall of Remembrance. The funding for the plaques, which display the name, cadet photograph, and events that led to each graduates enshrinement, are provided by the Class of '59 through their endowment which supports the Commandant of Cadets.
