

## SENIOR ENLISTED LEADERSHIP COURSE

**Course Code:** 501799

**Duration:** 12 Days

**How To Apply:** See "Special Info"

**Prerequisites:** To attend this course, applicants must meet the following:

1. Be a Senior Chief or Master Chief Petty Officer on Active Duty. Reserve members will be issued "No Cost" orders and must request funding from servicing (fot). Members in paygrade E-7 may apply and attend on a space available basis. Priority is given based on paygrade and billet.
2. Verification of compliance with Maximum Allowable Weight (MAW) standards must be entered into Direct Access no more than 30 days prior to executing orders per ALCOAST 339/08.
3. Have one year obligated service remaining upon graduation.

- A. Name and EEMPLID
- B. Active Duty status
- C. Billiet description
- D. Primary and alternate course dates
- E. Contact information: Unit Name, Mailing Address for Pre-Course assignments, Phone number and primary email address
- F. Command endorsement: Commands should only endorse Senior enlisted leaders who they would also recommend for Master Chief selection. This course is not intended to facilitate advancement, but to increase performance when advanced.

**ADDITIONAL INFO:**

1. Pre-course assignments will be mailed 4-6 weeks in advance to be completed before class convening.
2. Orders are issued 4 to 6 weeks in advance of CLCVN date.
3. This course does not meet the requirement for advancement to E-8 or the requirement to be a graduate of the Chief Petty Officer Academy or other DOD Senior Enlisted Academies to be eligible for a CMC Gold Badge Position.

**CANCELLATION OF ORDERS**

Follow your applicable cancellation policy. At a minimum, send your cancellation message to TQC, LDC, and CG-133. Cancellations with less than 30 days notice result in lost quotas due to pre-course assignments.

The mission of this 80-hour, in-residence course is to create a highly motivated, educated and trained Senior enlisted cadre of Master Chief or future Master Chief Petty Officers for assignment to any position including special assignments such as CMC or RFMC. The course develops the higher-level management skills required of those critical positions by addressing human resource and organizational policies, professional communications, protocol, and the critical relationship between workforce and command. The course is developed within the Coast Guard's Leadership Framework and the 28 leadership competencies.
